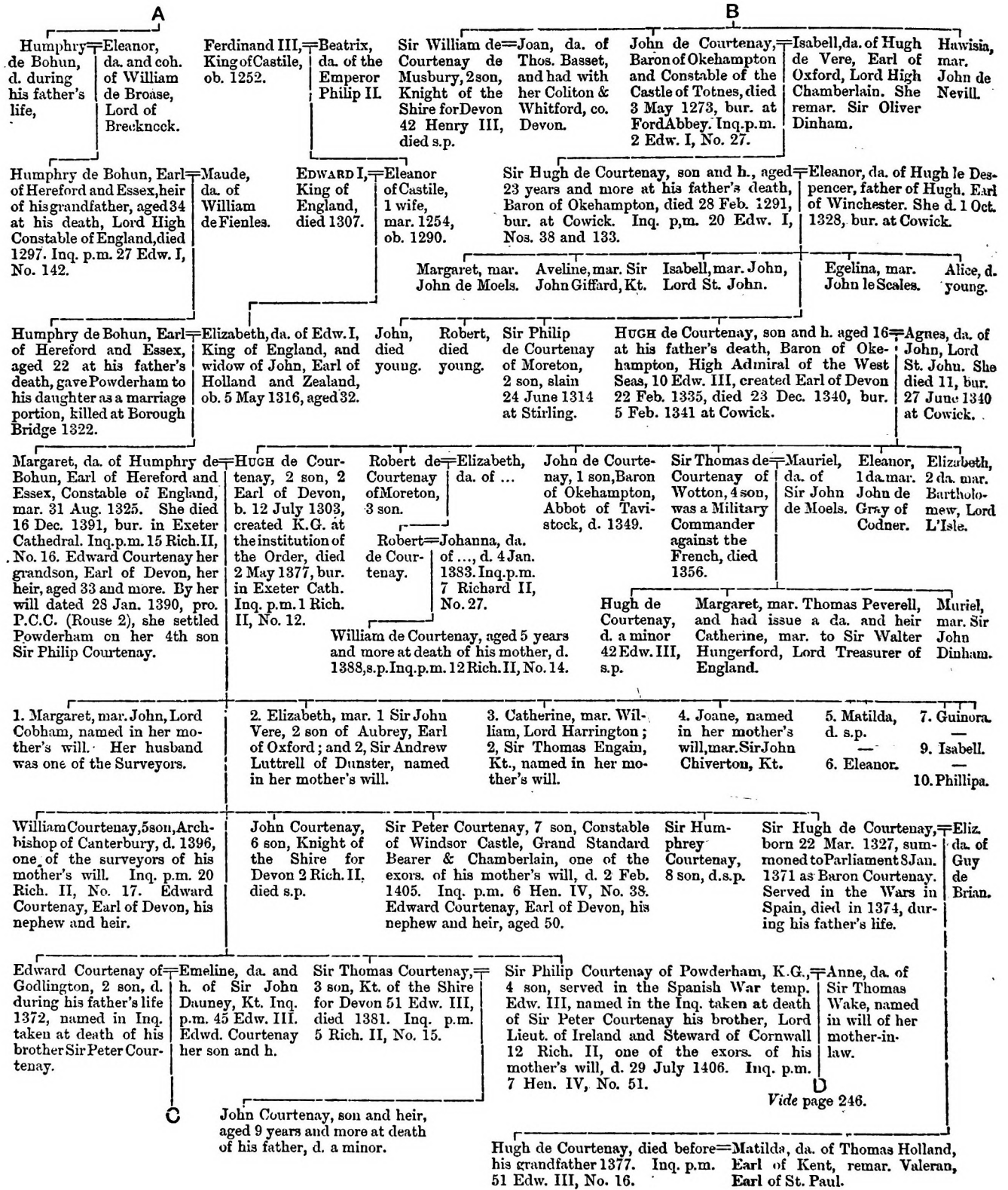

EDWARD Courtenay, 3 Earl of Devon, heir to his grandfather and aged 20 years and more 1378, also heir to his mother and grandmother, Admiral of the King's Fleet in the West Seas and Earl Marshal of England 8 Rich. II. Called "The blind Earl." Heir to his uncle the Archbishop of Canterbury, aged 40 and more 1396. Heir to his uncle Sir Peter Courtenay, and aged 50 years 1405. Died 5 Dec. 1419. Inq. p.m. 7 Hen. V, No. 75.

Matilda, da. of Thomas, Lord Camoys. Inq. p.m. 7 Edw. IV, No. 4.

Elizabeth, da. of Sir William Cogan and Sir Fulk Fitzwarren, 1 wife, died s.p.

Phillipa, da. of Sir Warrea Archdekne of Haccombe, 2 wife.

HUGH Courtenay, 4 Earl of Devon, son and heir, aged 30 at death of his father. Knight of the Bath at the Coronation of King Hen. IV, Commander of the Fleet and Lord High Steward of England, named in his great grandmother's will, died 16 June 1422, Inq. p.m. 10 Hen. V.

Anne, da. of Rich., Lord Talbot, died 16 Jan. 1441.

James Courtenay, served in the French wars, 8 Hen. VI, died s.p.

THOMAS Courtenay, 6 Earl of Devon, son and h., aged 26 at his father's death, adhered to the House of Lancaster, attainted and beheaded at York 4 Nov. 1461, s.p. when the original Earldom of Devon was forfeited.

Jane, mar. 1 to Sir Roger Clifford, Kt., 2 to Sir William Knivett, Kt.

Henry Courtenay, adhered to the House of Lancaster, attainted and beheaded at Salisbury 4 March 1467, s.p. Inq. p.m. 6 Edw. IV.

WILLIAM Courtenay, K.B. at Coronation of Hen. VII, Earl of Devon, was imprisoned by Hen. VII and released by Hen. VIII on his accession, but not restored in honors, named in his father's will, d. at Greenwich 9 June 1511, bur. with the honors of an Earl by command of the King.

Catherine Plantagenet, da. of King Edward IV, died 15 Nov. and bur. 3 Dec. 1527 in her chapel at Tiverton Castle.

Sir John Courtenay, adhered to the House of Lancaster, attainted 1 Edward IV, killed at the battle of Tewkesbury 14 May 1471, s.p.

EDWARD Courtenay, aged 12 at his father's death, and named in his will, imprisoned in the Tower during the reign of Hen. VIII, released by Queen Mary, and created Earl of Devon 3 Sep. 1553, fully restored in blood 10 Oct. 1553, died at Padua 18 Sep. 1556, s.p. Inq. p.m. 11 Ap., 3 and 4 Philip and Mary.
